he Mount Community Centre is pleased to announce that our Food Centre's Cafe has a new name! The construction of the Food Centre was completed due to the generosity of the Community Foundation of Greater Peterborough and an anonymous donor. The Cafe supports community sustainability and health, addressing issues of food security, while also creating and offering educational, employment and training opportunities for people of all ages. Current partnerships include the Community Training Development Centre, Meals on Wheels, VON's Adult Day Program and local daycares.

Cafe operations began this Fall and we offer delicious food to those who live, work and visit TMCC. The Café is currently open five days α

week from 8:00am-2:00pm offering breakfast, lunch and in-house catering services. The Café aims to keep prices low so that everyone can gather and eat in the café regardless of socio-economic status.

This is a major milestone for food security in our community and marks the culmination of five years of planning, positioning and community support. With the construction complete, the organization is continuing to seek additional funds to further equip the space through our *Building Opportunity Campaign*.
